All students achieving in the NAPLAN 2019 higher bands at Year 3 &amp; 5 will be retained in these bands.</p>	If we adopt a common approach in explicitly teaching strategies, aligned to the Big 6 Comprehension guidelines, for interpreting explicit information, we will increase student achievement in reading in years 5-7.	Students will consistently apply the "Fab 4" reading comprehension strategies (predicting, questioning, clarifying and summarising) within guided reading lessons, and be able to articulate the strategies being used when questioned.
